CRO ACE ASKING

When You or Partner Bids 4 C - It Can Only Be CRO

(Unless it is obvious that it is competitive:

For example, 1♣, 1♥, 2♣, 2♥, 3♣, 3♥, <u>4♣</u> - this is competitive not CRO)

RESPONSES TO 4 🛧 ARE:

- 4 None or Three Aces
- 4♥ One or Four Aces
- 4 Two Aces the Same <u>C</u>olour (C) That is, A♦ and A♥ **or** A♣ and A♠ If you have one or two aces you know exactly what partner's aces are with a 4♠ bid.
- 4NT Two Aces the Same <u>R</u>ank (R) That is, A♦ and A♣ **or** A♥ and A♠ If you have one or two aces you know exactly what partner's aces are with a 4NT bid.
- 5♣ Two Aces, that are <u>Opposite</u> (O) That is, A♣ and A♥ O**r** A♦ and A♠ If you hold only one ace, when partner shows two aces you know which two they are.
- Asking for Kings is exactly the same, only one level higher. That is at the five level.


